



## Glen Rock Police Department Identity Theft Packet



You were provided this packet because you reported to the Glen Rock Police Department that you were a victim of identity theft. There are several items in this packet that will assist you in protecting your vital information in the future (**KEEP YOUR GOOD NAME**) and attempting to repair your identity now (**GET BACK YOUR GOOD NAME**). There are also forms for you to fill out that will help the police further investigate your ID Theft.

Although you have filed an Incident Report, more information is required for the detective bureau to properly investigate this crime. The Incident Report is just the first step and you will usually need to provide a copy of that to your bank or financial institution that suffered a loss in your name. This initial Incident Report will allow your bank to properly handle their end of the crime so that you are not responsible for any fraudulent charges.

Unfortunately, most financial institutions will not prosecute the crime any further. In certain circumstances, the Glen Rock Detective Bureau may be able to further investigate and prosecute the individuals who have perpetrated this crime against you. In order to determine if that will be possible, it is important that you fill out the included **IDENTITY CRIME INCIDENT DETAIL FORM** (11 pages) to the best of your ability and return it to the Glen Rock Detective Bureau. The Detective Bureau will review the information you have provided and contact you if the matter will be investigated further. If the matter can be prosecuted, the actors will be charged and it may further help you protect and repair your ID Theft.

Additionally, to help you in your current situation, there is a **REMEDYING THE EFFECTS OF IDENTITY THEFT** and an **ID THEFT AFFIDAVIT**. The ID Theft Affidavit will assist you in presenting your case to any companies that your name has been used to open an account or charge items. The affidavit was not produced by the Glen Rock Police Department and contains its own instructions for you to follow. Please read them carefully. It is only provided as a means to assist you during this confusing time.
